From the Pastor



Brad has a friend who several years ago had an intriguing greeting on his answering machine. Yes, this was in the days before voice mail! He ended his greeting with the

affirmation, "Ready for the revolution!" Given his friend's commitment to African people worldwide, this revolution might have referred to the overthrow of tyrannical ideologies and practices that oppress Black people. Given his friend's commitment to Christ, this revolution could also carry profound religious implications. His declaration of revolutionary readiness might have been a subtle reminder that all powers in this world, political and otherwise, must eventually answer to a divine ruler whose sovereignty is absolute. Brad wondered if the phrase, "ready for the revolution" is an apt summary of the significance of Jesus' baptism by John.

In baptism, Jesus declared his readiness for the revolution represented by the reign/realm/ kingdom of God. The realm of God is a new world order wherein God will set right all that sin, evil, and death have put awry. lesus declared that he was ready to join in the movement whereby God's justice and peace will be manifest, not only in our lives, but throughout the entirety of all creation. Jesus waded into our human pathos, ready to take it upon himself to bring a revolution, a complete reversal of the status quo of sin, evil, and death.

This understanding of Jesus' baptism affects how we understand our baptism. In baptism, we affirm the work of Christ in the forgiveness of our sins, making whole what is broken in our lives, the healing of our hurts and pains, the gift of eternal life. Additionally, in baptism, we affirm the call to join in Christ's

work. We, and the church, are called to live out the revolutionary implications of baptism. As we move into 2023, what will this look like in our church, in our community, in your life?


