Dear Friends,

We have just returned from a vacation week in the Big Bend area of Texas.

Thank you so much for including times in the year for us to recharge. We stayed in Alpine and took day trips out from there. We saw many examples of God's Creative power while we were gone; the mountains of Big Bend National Park, the waste lands of the Chihuahua Desert, the beauty of the blooming Big Bend Blue Bonnets.

Perhaps the most impressive display we saw was at the McDonald Observatory near Ft. Davis. Outreach & Evangelism

Benevolences have been set and approved for 2015. Of the \$3000, \$600 will go to both North Dallas Shared Ministries and Metrocrest Social Services, \$400 will go to both Austin Street and Presbyterian Children's Homes and Services. The other \$1000 will go to 2—\$500 scholarships to graduates of W.T. White who went to Cabell Elementary and Marsh Intermediate Schools and plan to attend a local Community College or Trade School.

\$125 was collected for the Souper Bowl of Caring, which will be split evenly between North Dallas Shared Ministries and Metrocrest Social Services.
