In the eye of the storm ...



Several weeks ago, we heard the story of Jesus' disciples in the midst of a storm. Last week, we heard the story of the Israelites thirsting in the wilderness. 2020 seems

like a nightmarish amalgamation of these two images. We are on a wilderness journey in the eye of the storm. We grieve loss upon loss. We're frustrated, angry, confused and disillusioned at life around us. We've had enough of it all. 2020 has been a train wreck! Yet, the journey continues in the eye of the storm.

This is our context for ministry, worship, and mission as a community of Christ-followers. As we journey in the wilderness in the eye of the storm, Christ continues to call us to glorify God, grow disciples, and meet the needs of our neighbors. Yet, the church office is closed, and staff is working remotely, we are doing our best to worship on-line, classes are also on-line, and, all of our meetings and gatherings are via Zoom. While

we are finding new and creative ways to be faithful in mission and ministry, it remains before us. How are we called to be stewards of our resources when in the eye of the storm? The temptation is to drawback; God leads us into the storm.

We haven't stopped doing and being the church. We enter stewardship season weary and apprehensive. However, in the power of the Spirit we endure, "and endurance produces character and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint us because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us." (Romans 5:4-5) God is present in our midst to guide and deliver in the victory of Christ.

On each of the Sundays during October, we will highlight how we are enduring in our mission and ministry together. This Sunday we will draw attention to the necessary workings of the church. This will be

So, I know that you will be prayerfully considering how God is calling you to be faithful and generous in the year that lies ahead.

Let's continue to choose compassion and kindness, love and mercy. Let's be peacemakers and advocates of justice. Let's commit to care. Stay connected with each other!
