

# From the Pastor

Advent is a quiet time of preparation for the gift of a miraculous presence – God with us!



The countdown begins; creative turkey leftovers are on the menu; Black Friday/Thursday and Cyber Monday give way to the diminishing days until Christmas. These cultural messages want to

induce us into a buying panic. It pretty much works, as one feeding frenzy presses hard into the next.

Yet, the church has its own countdown – Advent. The church begins its new year when the days are still getting darker. The season rejects shallow sentimentality and false cheer. The images that greet us at the beginning of Advent are not swaddling clothes, twinkly stars, and fleecy lambs but images that startle us out of our complacency.

Advent is nothing like the consumer manic depressive panic of the holiday countdown. Advent is a quiet time of preparation for the gift of a miraculous presence – God with us! It is a reflective period that prepares us to receive a gift far greater than the latest high-tech gotta-have thing. The voices of heaven draw us to the gift which comes into the world and into our lives, not abstractly, but cradled in dirt and mangered in mystery.

During the season of Lent, we give up something that leads us to reflect on the self-giving sacrifice of lesus on the

cross. Advent is different. Advent is an opportunity to align ourselves with the "game changing" approach of God that occurs on Christmas morning. Advent is a time we get in "sync" with the amazing story of salvation and redemption God

unwraps for all creation in the birth of a baby. Advent is meant to draw us not to the retail stores, on-line or in malls, but to the Christ child. Into the darkness of December there comes not a sale, but a birth of hope to the despairing, comfort to the grieving, strength to the weak, deliverance to the discouraged, hope to the wanting, peace to the troubled, and joy to the sorrowful.

I invite you to embrace this season of Advent in worship and prayer, study

and community. Remember that how things are now is not how they have always been, and that it's not how they always will be. Remember that God's kingdom has come, is growing among us, and the time will come when it fills the world with peace, justice, healing,



reconciliation, love and joy. Pray for the coming of Christ to those around the world whose poverty, pain, and grief make God's kingdom seem remote. Pray for the coming of Christ to our community so that we might express love and compassion for all to

receive. Pray for the coming of Christ in your life that the light of hope, faith, love and joy will shine bright today, tomorrow, and all days until all things are on earth as they are in heaven.

Welcome to Advent! I will look forward to seeing you in worship and in community!


